**Subject:** Beach opening

Dear Shoreham Village Residents,

Welcome to Summer 2020!

Here is information regarding the beach opening, as well as reminders regarding use of the deck.

### **BEACH OPENING**

Our beach opened yesterday, June 26<sup>th</sup>, with Lifeguard coverage. Lifeguards will be on duty starting at 10:30am every day. They will go off duty at 5pm Monday through Thursday, and at 6pm on Friday and Sunday. Lifeguards will go off duty at 7pm on Saturdays.

The restrooms in the downstairs of the Village Hall will now be open during the lifeguarded beach hours stated above.

**FOR THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF ALL RESIDENTS, THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES FOR RESTROOM USE MUST BE FOLLOWED:**

1. Masks must be worn while walking to and from the beach and restroom, and while in the restroom.
2. Please use hand sanitizer, available by the door, before entering the restroom.
3. ONLY ONE (1) person may use the restroom at a time.
4. While waiting to use the restroom, please wait out on the lawn, maintaining a social distance of six (6) feet from others. THERE WILL BE NO CONGREGATING IN THE LOWER LEVEL OF THE BUILDING OR UNDER THE DECK.
5. Please wash your hands thoroughly, according to posted guidelines, after using the restroom.
6. Please dispose of all paper towels, tissues, etc. properly in the garbage cans provided.

\*Currently, the maximum capacity for the beach is 50%, or 125 people. We ask that you limit your guests, especially over the 4<sup>th</sup> of July, so that all our residents are able to enjoy their facilities.

\*\*Please remember, there are NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE DECK, LAWN OR BEACH.

### **DECK USE**

We are reminding all who want to enjoy the deck of the following:

1. MASKS MUST BE WORN WHILE ON THE DECK AT ALL TIMES. If residents are unable to follow this guideline, we will regrettably need to close the deck to all, with the exception of those with limited mobility.

2. In following the guidance of NYS Department of Health, there may be no more than 25 people gathered on the deck at any one time.
3. To the best of your ability and within the confines of the deck, non-household members must maintain a social distance of 6 feet from each other.

We apologize for the temporary inconvenience, but the health and safety of all our residents is our primary concern during this COVID-19 Pandemic.
