

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 OF 2017

**A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING APPOINTMENT
OF A RESIDENT OF SUFFOLK COUNTY
AS DEPUTY CLERK-DEPUTY TREASURER**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF
SHOREHAM AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

New York Public Officers Law Section 3 requires that a person holding a civil office be a resident of the political subdivision in which one serves. This local law recognizes residency in Suffolk County within which the Village of Shoreham is located as acceptable under the aforesaid Section 3.

SECTION 2. ENACTMENT.

In lieu of any other residency requirement imposed by law, the Deputy Clerk-Deputy Treasurer of the Village of Shoreham may reside in Suffolk County.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY.

Should any part or provision of this local law be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the local law as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.
