

**PUBLIC NOTICE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Shoreham will hold a public hearing on the 12th day of December, 2017, at 7:30 P.M., at the Village Hall, 80 Woodville Road, Shoreham, New York, to consider the adoption of a local law as follows:

**LOCAL LAW NO. \_\_\_\_ OF 2017**

**A LOCAL LAW ENTITLED  
SOLICITATION**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF SHOREHAM, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The Village Board finds that Village residents' interest in privacy outweighs any rights of any third party to engage in uninvited solicitation on private property. The purpose of this local law is to protect the privacy of residents and prevent fraud by prohibiting the uninvited presence of commercial vendors on private property within the Village.

SECTION 2. ENACTMENT.

A Chapter [\_\_] of the Village Code entitled **Solicitation** is enacted, as follows:

**§ [\_\_]. Definitions.**

As used in this Chapter [\_\_], the following defined terms shall have the meaning indicated:

(1) **person** - any individual, organization, society, association, company, corporation or other business entity or their agents or representatives.

(2) **solicitation** - any of the following:

(a) the selling or offering for sale or soliciting orders for the sale of any goods, wares, property or merchandise.

(b) the soliciting for subscriptions for any book, publication, paper, magazine or periodical.

(c) the seeking of employment or the soliciting of orders for work, labor or services, whether to be performed within or without the Village.

(3) **Village** - Village of Shoreham.

#### § [\_\_]. **Prohibited Acts.**

It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in solicitation by going from house to house upon private property within the Village.

#### § [\_\_]. **Penalties.**

Any person committing an offense against or violating any section or provision of this Chapter [\_\_] shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a fine not exceeding two hundred fifty (250) dollars or imprisonment not exceeding fifteen (15) days, or both. In lieu of or in addition to any fine or imprisonment, or both, imposed hereunder, each such offense may be punishable by a civil penalty not to exceed two hundred fifty (250) dollars to be recovered in an action or proceeding in a court of competent jurisdiction. For each day such offense or violation continues, the violator shall be subject to a separate civil penalty.

#### § [\_\_]. **Supersession.**

This local law shall supersede any inconsistent law, state or local. This declaration of supersession is made by authority of the Village's municipal home rule law powers, pursuant to §§ 10(1)(ii)(a)(14) and 10(1)(ii)(e)(3) of the Municipal Home

Rule Law, § 10(6) of the Statute of Local Governments, and Article 9, § 2(b)(3) of the New York State Constitution.

**§ [\_\_]. Severability.**

If any provision of this Chapter [\_\_] is ruled unconstitutional or invalid, such ruling shall not affect the validity of any other provision of said chapter or said chapter as a whole.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.

All persons in interest will be heard by the Board of Trustees at the public hearing to be held as aforesaid and may appear in person or by representative. The Village Hall is accessible to handicapped persons.
